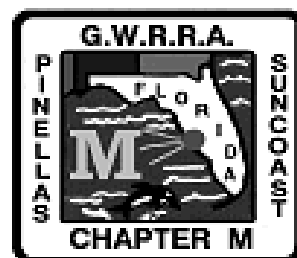

CHAPTER EDUCATORS

Blind Spots

We all are aware about the blind spots (No Zone on a truck) where a truck driver has difficulty in seeing, both cars and motorcycles. Cars also have a blind spot and we can easily be lost to their vision while riding near them. There are several things that we can do to minimize the danger to us.

The first and most obvious choice is to not ride next to another vehicle. We realize that this is not always possible, but when you have a choice pass another vehicle as fast as possible, or let them pass you by slowing up.

A lot of our chapter rides wearing reflective and/or highly visible vests and this also will help drivers see us. Wearing clothing (including armored jackets) that are contrasting colors to our bikes is also an attention getter. Also select the color of the helmet to contrast with the bike to make yourself as visible as possible.

Riding with modulating headlights is also another good tool for helping us be seen. Also adding additional lights to your bike and of course our “show chrome” is also an attention getter.

Be aware of your lane positioning. If you typically ride in the right track when passing a vehicle in the right hand lane you don't allow yourself much room to avoid the vehicle if they start changing lanes toward you. If you are in the left track you have about ½ of a lane between you and the vehicle and this gives more time to maneuver and blow your horn to alert the driver you are there.

Do these types of encounters always happen on interstate types of highways? Of course they don't. Some of the most dangerous times occur when you are in heavy traffic that is barely moving at all. Typically some driver is going to become anxious to move and will change lanes in an instant if they think there is an opening and that the other lane is moving faster. Of course they didn't see the motorcycle there when they started the lane change. This is likely to be considered a low speed crash, but those can hurt badly.

Until next month we hope that everyone will ride safe and always enjoy the ride.

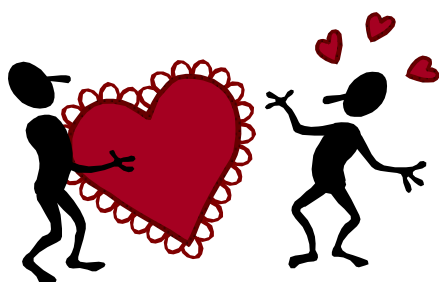
